Striper Diaries EPISODE 51

Winter Blues. Now that winter is in full swing, it's a good time to take an inventory of all your fishing gear. This is probably one of the most important projects any angler can do. This kind of log book is key and can be extremely helpful when

trying to determine when reels need new line, and which rods may need repair. Its also a great time to change hooks on your favorite plugs, check dates on safety equipment and figure out what gear needs replacement. With wait times longer than usual, I suggest getting a head start.

Another favorite past time, is making the rounds at our local fishing flea markets. There are several local events that are worth mentioning, and for those willing to travel the possibilities are even greater. Next Saturday March 2, 2024 is the Ward Melville Saltwater Seminar and Fundraiser; open from 8:30am to 3:00pm. Seminars and a panel of experts covering topics ranging from live bait striped bass fishing to surf fishing, tying teasers and rod building. Free Admission! Don't miss out on this event. March 16, 2024 is the Annual Long Island Fly Fishing Expo located at the Radisson Hotel, 110 Vanderbilt Motor Parkway in Hauppauge from 9:00am to 4pm. Admission \$10.00, kids under 18yrs free with paid adult. March 24, 2024, is the Fisherman Flea Market located at the American Legion Babylon Post #94 located at 22 Grove Place, Babylon. Sunday March 24, 2024 is also the fisherman flea market located at 118 Cassata Court, West Babylon. Everything fishing from 9am to 4pm. Don't miss these great events.

Finally, for those wishing to purchase the Four Wheel Drive Beach access pass, permits went on sale at the end of December 2023, and will continue until March 31, 2024. Remember, that all sales are online only and you must register first for a free fishing license. The cost is \$80 for NY residents and the permit is valid from April 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024 at Gilgo and Robert Moses. Valid year round at Hither Hills, Montauk Point and Napeague State Parks. Another option is the Camp Hero Access permit which is \$40 for NY residents and is valid from April 1 to December 31, 2024 at Camp Hero. All applications must include the following: (1) a valid motor vehicle registration; (2) driver's license of the motor vehicle registrant; and (3) a NYSDEC recreational salt water marine fishing registry.

Lets hope 2024 is great a fishing season for all our members.
