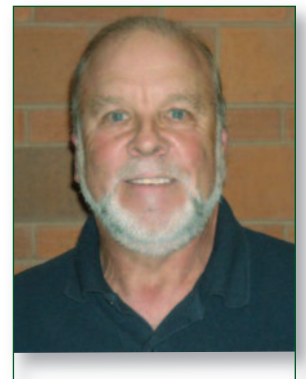

Fishing Report

Congratulations to all of our 2012 award winners. Both Captains & anglers worked very hard to achieve these awards and we share in your pride of being in the winner's circle at our next general meeting.

As of this writing we will already be setting our clock ahead in preparation for our 2013 season...so it will not be long before we are in full swing.

On a recent note; the fall mackerel run never happen this winter. Usually when this happens our spring May run for mackerel shows a strong possibility. Mackerel makes one of our best local bait catches. If you plan on chasing the schools this May here is a little tip to keep those baits pristine:

Before leaving to fishing load your boat with 4 boxes of coarse Kosher Salt. Next get the largest cooler available. Place two boxes of salt into the cooler. Add crushed ice & top the cooler off with sea water. Once the brine has been prepared it is ready for your freshly caught mackerel. The key to good brine is to place the mackerel directly into the brine while they are still alive. The fish inhale the solution and they become semi frozen which makes them a prime hook bait come fishing time.

Still on the local front the inshore wrecks are still producing keeper blackfish. Bottom "Hammer" Nick Nero reports some fair catches of Cod & Sea bass on the offshore wrecks.

On the southern front I vacationed for a week in Islamorada Florida. I had the pleasure of fishing with Captain Mike Wagner, Mike Zullo, Joe Fanora & Bobbie Hindenlang on Captain Mike's 34 Duffy. The boat was set up perfectly for the Florida reefs. We started each day in the bay pin fishing for bait. Next off too the reef for some great catches of Yellow tails, Groupers, Little Tunny and even some very interesting Moray Ells. At the dock we filleted our catch for a great fish dinner and Lazy Days Restaurant. A great way to take the edge off of winter and come back north to longer days and breaking weather. Thanks Captain Mike...

Annual Offshore Cod Trip May 3 - 5, 2013

This is the fourteenth year that the Freeport Tuna Club will be running its spring time fishing extravaganza. We will be sailing aboard the Viking Starship departing from Montauk once again. In past years we have traditionally fished off the coast of Massachusetts at the Stellwagon National Marine Sanctuary for Cod, Pollack, Haddock, Wolfish and other mixed species. Impending regulations could derail fishing in that area. We are planning on heading offshore south of Montauk to some of Capt. Steven Foresberg's secret wrecks which he is saving for our trip. We will be targeting Cod, Hake, Pollack and other species on day one. On day two we will hit some offshore wrecks off the coast of Nantucket. If the weather is not conducive for the offshore trip and the impending regulations are not enacted upon then we will head back up to Stellwagon Bank and enjoy the traditional fishery which has not disappointed us in the past. The boat will be leaving Montauk Friday evening May 3rd at approx 7:00PM and returning back to Montauk Sunday evening May 5th at approx 10:00PM. The fare for this year's trip is \$ 320.00 and will be strictly limited to 35 anglers. I will be collecting payment in full at the upcoming General Meeting which is scheduled for March 14th 2013.

If you are interested or on the fence about going on this trip, please take note that there are a limited number of spots available so sign up now and you will not miss the boat. This is one of the best events that the club runs and if you are into club camaraderie then look no further as you will enjoy plenty of that on this trip.

We start off 2013 with Cod and Winter Flounder. These are 2 great derbies to target to pick up a derby or annual award.

Catch of the Month 70 lb. Freshwater Striped Bass

With local fishing slow, we had no entries for catch of the month so we had to look beyond the FTC.

Pictured is James R. Bramlett, who landed this 70 pound striped bass from the Black Warrior River, in Alabama, near the Gorgas Steam Plant Thursday February 28, 2013. The fish was weighed on certified scales, is "only" 45.5 inches long but has an incredible 37.75 inch girth. It is fairly not uncommon for landlocked stripers to exhibit these unusual proportions. The catch topped the previous Alabama state record by 15 pounds, and is a pending IGFA world record for landlocked striped bass, which currently stands at 67 pounds, 8 oz.



The current IGFA record is 81 lbs., 14 oz caught in Westbrook CT. on August 4th, 2011 by Gregory Myerson. The current FTC stands at 61 lb. 12 oz. caught by Vincent Pastors in 1967.
