

FISHING REPORT

TOUGH FEBRUARY, BRING ON SPRING



Sitting here writing this report there is snow in the forecast but milder temps ahead. We have just endured a savage February with some of the coldest temps on record and an abundance of snow too. The bays and canals took on a good freeze, at one point I saw a solid 4 inches of ice along the edges of Woodcleft canal. One of the Town of Hempstead tugs has been making trips up and down the canals almost daily keeping the channels clear



and breaking up ice, helping to prevent it from clinging to pilings, docks, boats, etc. I have not seen too many casualties of a result of the winter, although a party boat did go down at the Captree dock.

Fishing options are severely limited due to icing and weather. Nobody sailed for two or three weeks. This past weekend a

couple of west end party boats fished wrecks in the Mudhole area with just a fish or two to report for the entire boat.

Not very good.

The Moriches based King Cod broke some ice and made a few very successful COD trips. I believe the areas further east along the south shore are less affected by freshwater runoff and enjoy slightly warmer water temps overall, allowing their fishery to sustain. But, you have to be able to get off the dock to fish. The Montauk fleet has been iced in.

St. Patrick's Day is right around the corner and the traditional start of the winter flounder season. In New York, the season opens April 1st and runs to May 30th, 2 fish per person. There is talk of greatly lengthening the season from March 1st to December 31st , but as one guy put it, "now you'll be able to catch none, almost year round". Fishing in the south shore bays is way down, but some opportunities exist.

Seabass, fluke, and striped bass regulations are all being scrutinized. It looks as if seabass will be more restricted (bad), fluke status quo (good), striped bass to be determined.

Captain Joe Masseria has been following the FTC reports from down in Jupiter Florida and thought it was time to chime in. He reports, "the large mouth bass fishing on the property is a steady alternative when the wind is blowing which is pretty much always in Florida. Did get out on a recent calm day with my good friend Conrad and we had a Florida grand slam,1 nice blue marlin, 1 sail, a couple of mahi, and some king fish. Trip to the keys with

my son Keith for back country action was awesome. Non stop redfish all day with some shots at snook and tarpon. No wind flat calm day." Pictured is Joe with a 15 lb. Red caught on 10 lb. mono. Well, that beats our non-existent local action and horrendous weather, no



doubt. Thanks for the reports Captain Joe.

Better weather is coming and the 2015 season will unfold. I encourage all FTC members to please bombard me with reports and pictures to share with our membership. Thanks to all who contributed last year, it makes writing the Tuna Tower News report far more enjoyable.

As of today, according to the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation, it looks like the 2015 fluke season will be 5 fish at 18 inches, with a season from May 17 to September 21.

And don't forget to re-register for the recreational marine fishing registry. The registration lasts one year from the date of registration, so if you registered last spring you have to re-up this year. If there is any chance you might be traveling west you need to be registered in New Jersey also, as the garden state does not accept the NY registration. There is a link on the club website for both the New York and New Jersey registrations.
