## STRIPER DIARIES EPISODE 28

Ready, Set, Go!!! With opening day around the corner, most of us are getting ready for the spring fishing season. With that in mind, it is important to review some new and old important safety tips. The first is Brianna's law, which require every boat operator to take a safe boating course depending on your birth year. Here is the breakdown: if you were born on or after 1993, a boating safety certificate was required last year; if born on or after 1988, the certificate is required in 2022; if born on or after 1983, the certificate is required in 2023; and if born on or after 1978, the certificate is required in 2024. For all others operators, regardless of age, a certificate will be required by 2025.

On the fishing front, all anglers must enroll in the Recreational Marine Fishing Registry. Anglers fishing for Tuna and Shark must also apply for a Migratory Species permit. Keep in mind that the fishing regulations were last updated May 8, 2020, and are subject to change at any time. That being said, here is the latest...for those early birds, Tautog season for both the Long Island Sound and NY Bight Region opens April 1, 2021 and closes April 30, 2021. The size limit is 16 inches and 2 fish per angler. Hurry up and get in on the action, as the season is short and will not reopen again until October 11th , and 15th respectively. Remember to bundle up as water temperatures remain quite chilly, and a life jacket is required on all pleasure boats less than 21 feet until May 1, 2021.

April 1, 2021 is opening day for Striped Bass north of the George Washington Bridge. The slot size is 18-28 inches and 1 fish per angler. For those of us closer to home, and south of the GW Bridge, opening day is April 15, 2021. The slot size is 28-35 inches and 1 fish per angler. You will find fish in their usual places this time of year. For me, that means a trip (or several) to Raritan Bay. There are several reports of fish already being caught. In fact, Bobby Read of Back Bay Plugs caught and released a 58 pound striped bass this morning from his Hobie Kayak on a green and white plug!! You can find the full report on New Jersey, Delaware Bay edition of the Fisherman Magazine.

I hope to be on the water soon and get in on the action! Stay safe and until my next adventure, Tight Lines.
