


President's Message

If you are holding any slips, please remember we must have them in hand no later than 14 days after the derby close in order to be eligible for derby awards. All slips that we receive figure into our annual awards, so if possible, get your fish weighed.

Striper Diaries EPISODE 37

WINDY....I cannot remember a spring this windy or cold in a long time. In fact, my boat is still on my trailer and its May 10!!! Typically, by now I would have driven up to Piermont Pier to cast blood worms into the Hudson River;

taken a trip hiking into the woods off Little Neck Bay casting paddle tails with jig heads; then hiked by foot into Jamaica Bay at dawn tossing bucktails and finally a voyage to Raritan Bay for striped bass. The word has gotten out that the New Jersey Raritan Bay bite has been very hot for weeks. Unfortunately, most people out of Jones Inlet have had limited weather windows to make the run. Fish in Raritan Bay are biting on the usual suspects - - mojos and flutter spoons with tons of slot fish being caught. Congrats to the few club members who made the trip and were rewarded with quality fish. With the price of fuel, let's hope those fish swim east and decide to feed and stay in our local waters.

The buzz around town is still last year's hot tuna bite. A big thanks to Harry and James Weinblatt for sharing their knowledge of tuna fishing at last month's meeting. They were kind enough to bring their gear and give detailed demonstrations on how to properly rig the line and even gave a lesson on harpooning. If we pray hard enough to the fish gods, those tuna may show up again in our backyards.

On the fluke front, changes were made to the regulations for the 2022 season. It may be small, but it helps. The season opened May 1, 2022 and closes October 9, 2022! That is a longer season than we have had in the past. Anglers can possess 4 fish with a minimum size of 18.5 inches. New Jersey had changes as well. The New Jersey season opened May 2, 2022 and closes September 27, 2022. Anglers can possess two fish @ 17-17.99 inches (less than 18) and one fish @ 18 inches or over. Sound confusing? It is! Catchem up!

Finally, I want to say a big thanks to Tom Leprine, his son Mike and to Rick Totten. The great thing about our club is the way we all help each other - whether it's fishing questions, or how to tie a rig or boat maintenance. I was blessed to have their help over these past few weeks with numerous boat repairs. Thanks guys! I really appreciate your knowledge and wisdom!! Stay safe.

Fishing Report

With the start of the bass season on April 15th there has been plenty of action down to the west in Raritan and off Sandy Hook. Fish have been responsive to those trolling and tossing lures. On the local front the bass are around in the back bays in good numbers and are readily taking soft plastics and other stick baits retrieved slowly.

Blackfish is now closed, fishing was slow but decent catches were put together with a nice mix of cod all on the local pieces.

For anyone making the trip the canyon has had a solid tilefish bite, with good numbers of school bluefin hitting tile rigs on the way up and down.

Fluke opened May 1st with 4 fish at 18½", fish are in the mud and lethargic but a few nice catches have been reported.
