# **Fishing Report**

No word yet on our spring mackerel run, however if history proves correct, they should make their appearance in very late April to early May.

On a conservation note:

Fluke season will be May 1st ~ September 29th Four (4) fish @ 19" Much better that we could have imaged.

Seabass season will open on July 23th. This late opening is a bite disappointing knowing that the commercial season will be opened much earlier.

Reports are coming from our members. So here is the latest:

To the west Captain Steve Rodeos F/V" Legacy" Reports that the Strip Bass have arrived in full force in Ratian Bay. Keeper size fish have been caught on Clam bait & spoons.

Captain Chris on a recent trip to Fire Island reports that there are some quality flounders to be caught in the N/S Fire Island Channel and that strip bass have already moved into our local bays. This report was re-enforced with and fine catch of keeper stripers on a night bite by Captain Peter Cefai & Barbara. Pete and Barbara fished the Western North Shore for the full moon on April 25, 2013 for the "night bite" on the boat the "NeverEnuff". The FTC Team chunked bunker & landed several nice bass up to 17 pounds.

On the offshore wreck scene the 20 mile wrecks are still covered with dog fish and seabass that we cannot keep. The better offshore action is on the 30 & 40 mile wrecks reports a nice size Cod fish.

The Winter Flounder Derby ends this Sunday, 5/12. You have until 5/26 to get slips in to the committee.

The Striped Bass Derby is on right now and ends on 6/09. The Weakfish Derby starts this Saturday, 5/11. We will have Sea Bass dates shortly.

## ANNUAL AWARD CHANGES.

We've made some changes to the annual awards in the interests of competition and participation.

**Woodcleft Marine Base, Inc., Trophy** — Awarded to the member catching the greatest weight fish per pound line test, on a boat sailing from any Long Island Port using a maximum of 30 lb. test line and conventional tackle. No Blue Sharks will be eligible for this award.

The change makes this award for "conventional tackle only".

# Ed Swanson Memorial Angler of the Year Award ---

Awarded to the angler sailing from any Long Island port who achieves the highest number of total points in a calendar year. Points are accumulated for the following species: Pelagic Sharks, Tuna, Bill Fish, Dolphin, False Albacore, Weakfish, Striped Bass, Fluke, Sea Bass, Blackfish, Bluefish, Cod and Flounder. Points are awarded for the 1st (5 pts.), 2nd (4 pts.), 3rd (3 pts.), 4th (2 pts.) and 5th (1 pt.) largest fish caught for each species.

The change adds False Albacore, counts the first 5 fish and changes the points awarded for each place.

**The Barry Simon Memorial Captain's Award** — Awarded to the captain who achieves the highest number of points for Cod, Blackfish and Sea Bass caught aboard his vessel. Points are awarded for the 1st (5 pts.), 2nd (4 pts.), 3rd (3 pts.), 4th (2pts.) and 5th (1pt.) largest fish caught for each species. A member captain may submit two weight slips for each species and must be aboard his vessel when the fish is caught. The boat must leave and return from Jones, Fire Island or Debs Inlet. The angler need not be a member.

The change allows 2 fish of each species per captain, counts the first 5 fish and changes the points awarded for each place.

# Catch of the Month Mutton Snapper

Our "Catch of the Month" goes to Jonathan Wade who caught some huge Mutton Snappers while vacationing in Belize recently. This beauty was landed along with a variety of other snapper species and reef dwellers. Style points were awarded for the clearly visible FTC hat as well.



No weight was obtained for this fish but it

looks like it might have challenged the "current" FTC record 16 lb 12 oz Mutton Snapper caught by John Shiel in Boyton Beach, Fla back in 1961. The IGFA All Tackle Record stands at 30 lb 4 oz caught at the Dry Tortugas in 1998.

# Conservation

The regulations are now final! Fluke and porgies have opened on May 1st. The fluke bag limit is four fish at 18 inches. The season will end on September 29th. The porgies season will run through December 31st. There is a 30 fish limit with a 10 inch minimum size. In September and October, the limit goes to 45 fish on party and charter boats.

The Sea bass season opens on July 10th and runs through December 31st. The new bag limit is 8 fish with a 13 inch minimum size. Remember to register to fish.




