



# FTC Fishing Report

We are finally here and the fishing season that we live for is now in fully swing. I hope we all have our 2012 NYS DEC Licenses... just a second reminder. If not here is the link: http://www.dec.ny.gov/permits/6091.html

On the offshore scene we mentioned last month about getting our NMFS Permits. There is some information out there that may be confusing, so I did some research and this is the bottom line;

If you want to recreationally fish shark & tuna you will need the recreational NMFS Permit @ a fee of \$20.00. For Charter head boat you can take two fish, even if you are recreationally fishing. HOWEVER



you MUST have the following to be in NY State compliance:

There MUST be a US Coastguard license holder on board. You MUST have the NYS DEC Charter Head boat Permit on board.

You need both once in NYS waters. All DEC Officers are deputized to enforce the law so for armed is for warned & sad stories of you did not know will not get you off the hook and the fines are very heavy. So do not be the "Poster Boy" of embarrassment and be in full compliance. The following links have more information to obtain you correct permit.

Still on the offshore scene it is official that Captain Chris Gerhart F/V Wasabi has once again achieved 1st Tuna of the year during a Chicken Canyon Day Trolling trip with club member Jimmy Meehan. Captain Chris pounds the pavement hard for this award, which makes it his 6th victory in 1st Tuna.....well done Captain Chris

The local reefs are stacked with quality Seabass. However you need to want until June 15th to keep your catch. Local Bottom Fisherman expert Captain Michael Zullo bagged a 7 pounder and may other quality Seabass on the local reefs, all released. So lock & load for what looks like to be a slammer Seabass Season.

Fluke are still in the bay so we will have to wait a little longer until our ocean fluke season starts. Captain Jim Krug on a recent Montauk charter bested a 12 pound fluke... so it does not get any better that that.

Bass fishing is red hot! The bunkers are stacked up on the beach big time! Paul Noto leads the derby with a 40 plus pounder, followed by Joe Masseria and Peter Montello with Bass in the 30 pound class. In addition to the outside action, both Captain Harry Weinblatt & Chris Bellinzoni report great bay bass fishing on clam bellies. All fish are keeper size.

Bottom fishing on our local wrecks and out as far as the 20 mile pieces are still producing nice keeper Codfish & Ling.

Off shore shark fishing will start this month. Currently reports from non club sources report plenty of blue sharks already. 1st Mako is wide opened. I will be doing a shark clinic in mid June at a Thursday Night Captain Angler event to assist all FTC members in catching there dream fish, so stay tuned for more on this clinic.

trollers. Within minutes are first of eight bluesharks all tagged and released. Then at 1130 the close rod went off with fury on a VSX16. New club member Artie "Jetmac" was strapped into the make that made a gray hound leap 30' from the boat. Art angled the fish for about 50 minutes as she pulled 18 pounds of drag with easy. The fish made a boat side appearance, but once close she




lit up the reel again. We motored the boat with MakoMat at the wheel, so I could line the fish up for a gaff shot. Once close, Artie did everything right Captain Bill Morrogh wired the mako and the 7 iron was dispatched into the mako. A done deal with a hang weight of a respectable 183 pounds.

It was a great way to start the shark season 1st trip out. The man in the Blue Suit is truly the king! The weigh slip was submitted for 1st Mako of the year.
