
PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

I would like to thank everyone who came down to the yearly yard clean up. It was a very hot day but a lot was accomplished and we are most grateful for your contribution. The yard looks great.


Thank you to Bruce Foster and the Southern Guns for a "Rockin" good time at the Captains and Anglers Barbecue. It was a lot of fun and a big success.

The Fluke Shootout will be held on Saturday, July 10th. I am hoping all members take advantage of a fun day of fishing and a barbecue with raffles later at the Club.














FLUKE CALCUTTA

The NYS fluke season opened on May 4 and runs through September 30, 2021. Charlie Goldstein and Mike Sullivan will once again be running the Fluke Calcutta. For those who are new, here is how it works. Entry is open to all members and their immediate family members - \$10 per person.

Largest fluke caught from anywhere by an entrant during the NYS season takes all. The fish must be caught on hook and line while free swimming. The rules are simple. But you've got to be in it to win it.

Last year Scott Novick won \$670 with an 11.3 lb. fish caught aboard his vessel *Naida*. I know he is planning to beat that this year. So are a lot of you. We will see.

FISHING REPORT

Local fishing has been good with fluke and plenty of bluefish and schoolie bass in the bays. The larger bass we've had have seen the move to the east.

Ocean fluke fishing around The Reef, Angler Banks, McAllister and Cholera, has been steady with some decent fluke fishing and sea bass.

Offshore Sporadic bluefin ahave been caught with some reports improving.

Tile fish still remain to be a good bet for those of you wishing to make the run.

Sharking has been good with plenty of threshers and some large ones in the mix have been taken and seem to be sweeeping all local tournaments.

Makos have been reported but out sze limits make it tough to harvest. Make sure before going fishing locally you have a fishing license and if you are targeting shark, bluefin or any other offshore highly migratory species that the vessel has an HMS valid permit

Know your Knots Shock Leader to Line



When leader is five times or more the pound/test of line, double ends of both leader and line back about 6". Slip loop of line through loop of leader far enough to permit tying Uni-Knot around both strands of leader.



2. With doubled line, tie Uni-Knot around the two stands of leader. Use only four turns.



Put finger through loop of line and grasp both tag end and standing line to pull knot snug around loop of leader.

4. With one hand pull standing leader (not both strands). With other hand pull both strands of line (see arrows). Pull slowly until knot slides to end of leader loop and all slippage is gone.

Double Line Shock Leader


 As a replacement for Birnini Twist or Spider Hitch, first clip off amount of line needed for length of loop desired. Tie the two ends together with an Overhand Knot.

2. Double end of standing line and overlap 6" with knotted end of loop piece. Tie Uni-Knot with tied loop around doubled standing line, making four turns.

The Uni-Knot System



3. Now tie Uni-Knot with doubled standing line around loop piece. Again four turns.



4. Hold both strands of doubled line in one hand, both strands of loop in other. (See arrows.) Pull knots together until they barely touch.

5. Tighten by pulling both strands of loop piece but only main strand of standing line. Trim off both loop tag ends, which eliminates Overhand Knot.


