At our board of directors meeting. Some changes were discussed in the standards for which we can achieve awards. The board has approved a second exemption to the IGFA rules. Under the rules for Equipment: Section G sub. -1 has been amended as

follows:

G. Hooks For Bait Fishing

Sub-1 for live or dead bait fishing no more than two single hooks may be used.

EXEMPT (voted 08/16/06 & grandfather to 01/15/06) Multiple hook rigs maybe used.

Example: "Jiggy's Rig"

For the upcoming season your Awards Committee will be reviewing all IGFA rules for changes or exemptions. This review will better serve our club and the way we fish. To date we currently have two exemptions: wire line and multi hook rigs.

PROPERTY


Winter storage contracts will go out this month to everyone who kept their boat there last year. If you want to add your name to the list, contact Mike Sullivan.


