With Hurricane Dorian arriving in the beginning of September really put a hault to the excellent fluke fishing that was occurring outside the local reefs. As multiple storms worked their way up the east coast, fisherman had a hard time getting out of the inlets and actually finding fish. As the seas continued to calm, there were plenty of bottom fish around from seabass to porgies to cocktail blues. But the fluke bite seemed to have disappeared. Even Montauk had a hard time sustaining fluke. Though there were very impressing catches far and in between of fish ranging from 6-18 pounds.



Mike Sullivan caught another 9 lb. fluke, I was able to get out on one of the last days of fluke fishing with club member Henry Dam and friends, catching nice quality fluke, seabass, and porgies. A nice way to close the fluke season.

On the inshore local front there has been plenty of blowfish and cocktail blues at the meadowbrook bridge.

Now to the off shore report. Jim Krug and son Bobby had a nice dressed 91 lb. tuna caught in the scallop fleet with good action all day. Bobby did hook up with a giant and fought it for 11/2 hrs before it popped the line.

I was lucky to sail on Capt. Gene Schettini's "Somewhere in Time" hooking up with my first yellow fin ever with plenty of Mahi and tile fish to go around the whole boat.

The night bite was pretty quiet except for Richard Olejnik hooking into a monster shark that eventually snapped the line.

Capt. Dave Pincus was also on the tuna grounds that weekend



hooking into a nice vellowfin, a few shark and some nice tile fish.

Looking forward, hopefully the bass will arrive soon and followed by the blackfish.







ARTICLE VIII: Nominating Committee

Section 1. The annual election of Directors shall be held at the November meeting of the Corporation. Officers shall be elected by the newly elected Board of Directors prior to the Annual Meeting which shall be held in January of each year and shall be installed at such January meeting.

Section 2. There shall be a Nomination Committee which shall be appointed by the President at the October meeting of the Board of Directors. Such Committee shall consist of six (6) members of whom three (3) shall be members of the Board of Directors and three (3) shall be Regular Members of the Corporation. The Nominating Committee will select the required candidates for the Board of Directors from among the members who have been active in Corporation affairs and who have shown their interest by attending meetings and participating in the various activities of the Corporation. Directors and Officers may be re-elected for any office. The report of the Nominating Committee must be mailed to the members of the Corporation prior to the November meeting.

Section 3. Nominations for Directors will be entertained from the floor at the November meeting. The name of the candidate must be proposed by a voting member and seconded by ten voting members and presented to the Secretary in writing at least seven (7) days prior to the November meeting.
