### Fishing Report

September sure did deliver big to get the fall fishing off to a great start.

The Fluke season ended strong with quality fish caught from Jones all the way to Montauk.

The local reefs and wrecks produced good number of sea bass and guite a few triggers in the mix.

Plenty of Schoolie bass and bluefish have been around both in the bays and inlets. Bigger fish are starting to be caught, a good sign of what is to come over the next few weeks. For anyone fishing clams at the bridges and local piers blowfish are being caught in good numbers.

Reports of the fall shark run have been coming in with catches of both makes and threshers. The 20-fathom curve has been holding fish with some reports of fish even closer.

The bluefin bite inshore remained solid all through September, Ralph Drews f/v No Mercy, Adam Bollaci f/v Hooker, Doug Toback f/v Corazon and Steve Bassford f/v The Bassman all had catches of quality Bluefin. Live bunker is still the hot bait of choice.

Further offshore the yellowfin bite is starting to come alive, nice catches of fish to 120 lbs. have been coming in. All the action is on bait, jigs and poppers. Bigeye and mahi are also still being caught.

Montauk - - whenever I get a chance to fish Montuak, I jump at the opportunity. Fall fishing can produce a mixed bag, and if fishing around the full moon, almost anything can happen. As we loaded the boat on the trailer and hit the road, we said a quick prayer to the fish gods. Montauk can produce big swell, and big fish, and this trip did not disappoint.

Our first day out was an exploratory mission. We figured we would look for birds and chase the bait. Getting the "lay of the land" is ex-


> tremely important when navigating in unfamiliar territory. As we broke the harbor, we were greeted with

bright sunshine and light west winds. The plan was to ride around and cast and blast looking for false albies and striped bass. We motored past Clark's Cove and North Bar, Jones Reef and finally out to the Point. With not much action in the way of birds we decided to drift and jig the bottom. Diamond jigs and

bucktails were deployed in the rips - wow that water moves fast. We were drifting at over 2 knots. With a west wind and an outgoing tide we were flying. To my surprise the bottom was loaded with keeper sea bass, por-

gies and trigger fish. Once the tide slowed down, we even got lucky with some 27 inch striped bass. That's a win-win for sure.

With the cooler loaded we headed back to the barn.

### ARTICLE VIII: Nominating Committee

Section 1. The annual election of Directors shall be held at the November meeting of the Corporation. Officers shall be elected by the newly elected Board of Directors prior to the Annual Meeting which shall be held in January of each year and shall be installed at such January meeting.

Section 2. There shall be a Nomination Committee which shall be appointed by the President at the October meeting of the Board of Directors. Such Committee shall consist of six (6) members of whom three (3) shall be members of the Board of Directors and three (3) shall be Regular Members of the Corporation. The Nominating Committee will select the required candidates for the Board of Directors from among the members who have been active in Corporation affairs and who have shown their interest by attending meetings and participating in the various activities of the Corporation. Directors and Officers may be re-elected for any office. The report of the Nominating Committee must be mailed to the members of the Corporation prior to the November meeting.

Section 3. Nominations for Directors will be entertained from the floor at the November meeting. The name of the candidate must be proposed by a voting member and seconded by ten voting members and presented to the Secretary in writing at least seven (7) days prior to the November meeting.
