Hope everyone had a good summer. It's time once again to fill up the yard with boats. Last year was great so I'm hoping for the same cooperation and patience from everyone so we can get the winter storage done with ease.

Same rules as last year. Send me a text or call when you know a week or so before you have your boat hauled and plan on bringing it to the property. If you are on a trailer, your jack **must** be in working order. That means the crank should be working and the wheel or skid plate should be working as well. If it's not in working order please replace it or it may be replaced at our discretion and you will be charged for it.

All trailers should have your name and number on it in case we have to contact you. When your boat is shrink wrapped please put your name and number in the bow area with a black sharpie type marker also.

If it has to be moved you will be called to let you know it has to be moved or if we notice something that needs to be addressed, such as shrink wrap ripped or compromised we can call you. Doing that makes it easier to figure out who's boat it is.

If you need a winter storage application send me an email and I will reply and send it to you. Get them in as soon as you can since it is on a first come first serve basis to reserve your spot.

As a reminder boats are no allowed on property without payment in full and also proof of insurance. Please put a copy of your insurance card with your payment. Thank you in advance for your cooperation and patience.

Fishing Report

When it comes to Fall fishing - October 2022 sure delivered as one for the record books. Out in the canyons and tuna grounds the bite was nothing short of epic. What started behind the draggers 60 miles out shifted to the Hudson, chunking and jigging produced solid catched of yellowfin, long fin and bigeye. The bite was solid overnight and even better during the day, the yellowfin were the 60-90 lb class and Bigeyes up to 78" were caught. Chris Lombardo and Steve Bassman were part of a crew that filled the boat with quality yellowfin all on the chunk. The Hooker sailed late in the month and put a solid catch together of yellowfin and longfin, filling the box in only a couple hours with an insane bite.

On the inshore front the bass came in early and all that got in on this bite were rewarded with catches of some of the biggest bass we have seen with many personal bests being caught. Fish to over 50" were reported with many between 45-50", plenty of slot fish were also in the mix. Both trolling and live lining bunker produced. Boats that were in on the action included



Oh Yeah, Corazon, No Mercy, Easy Rider, Hooker, Kingfisher, Joint Effort, Over the Rail, and Bassman - apologies if I missed anyone.

Cindy Weinblatt caught and safely released striped bass aboard Capt. Harry Weinblatt's *No Competition* Sunday, October 30th. 54 feet of water south of Long Beach on a Green Reliable Bunker Spoon.

On the blackfish end - the season has started out strong with the local bridges producing quality catches of keeper fish. Action on the local wrecks and reefs has been improving as the water cools. There was an annual club organized trip aboard *Brooklyn Girl* out in Orient where Gary Ferber and Bob Dimino took home the pool. Fishing was solid with limits around the boat for all. Thanks to Ken Donowski for organizing the trip.

For anyone fishing the north shore the bass and bluefish bite has also been lights out. Schoolies, slots and overs have been plentiful, with blitzes going off all through the day. Also worth noting that in the north shore bays we have been seeing monster bluefish to 36" tearing up gear.

Striper Diaries EPISODE 44

Is fishing really about catching big fish, or is it about the relationships we make along with way - well maybe a little bit of both. As October was approaching, I spent the last few weeks getting ready for our annual fall run trip to Montauk. Montauk is one of those special places on earth. Some people call it heaven, and I agree. It's where lifetime memories are made. My mom took us to Montauk every fall to

chase the striped bass migration. Those are memories that I will keep forever in my heart. After her passing, my brother and I decided we would keep the family tradition alive. It would not be the same without mom, but we would forge ahead and make new memories as adults. My brother is an avid fisherman, both from the surf and boat. After arriving from California, our plan was to trailer the boat and camper to the Mecca. Spend 15 days in search of big fish, while making priceless memories along with way.

We arrived in Montauk for the October full moon. Only this trip my brother had a surprise - a friend would accompany him. That very special friend was Jonathan Smith, custom plug builder from the Santa Cruz, Northern California area. Not only did Jonathan bring his latest custom plugs, he wanted us to become his "east coast testers" (No pressure). Jonathan spoke at length about his friend and mentor, legendary Mike Fixter known as "Pixie Mike." As the story goes, Jonathan was blessed to learn everything from Mike and was reluctant to take any credit at all. As he displayed each plug, he spoke in great detail about the construction. Each plug is made of Alaskan yellow cedar wood with quality components, including stainless steel wire, Spro swivels, HD stainless Steel rings, and VMC 4X hooks. No small detail is missed. What he explained, is that Alaskan cedar wood is very buoyant, does not take on water like other materials can, and is very durable to hook scrapes. Jonathan is humble, quiet and soft spoken. He is true master at his craft. I was blown away.

Now to put the plugs to the test. The plan was to wake up super early and head to the point and drift the rips. I had to give the 'ole disclaimer about how this could just be another boat ride. Truth is, I was nervous about even finding any fish. We ate dinner early and I went to bed at 7pm! I prayed all night to the fish gods, as I knew the pressure was on. There are times in your life when you just wish the stars would align - - and the tides, winds and weather would cooperate. Well my prayers were answered. As we headed out of the Harbor in the gray light, the wind was dead calm and the water was glass. Pete Cefai was at the helm and we decided to go straight to the rips. As we approached, we saw birds and the water

was glistening and bubbling. Holy crap! It was a sea of striped bass feeding on bait. Jonathan starts yelling - grab my plug and cast! Well I grabbed my 7ft. carbon shield rod, put on his plug, and threw it out as fast as I could. BAM! Fish on! It was lock and load, lights out, all out bonanza. We fished until late afternoon, landing fish on almost every cast while I was yelling out "I got another one" and "whoot whoot" "fish on." It was pure joy. Other boats were coming close and could not believe their eyes. At one point, another boat pulls up while I am fighting a cow and yells out "Battle hair Barbara - you're a bad ass." Let's just say, that is a moment going down in the books.

The following days were a carbon copy and both Jonathan and my brother Lee landed their personal best. It was a trip of a lifetime, making new friendships and memories along with way. Without a doubt, the plugs made all the difference! I am honored to be a part of the East Coast Team. If anyone is interested in
