FISHING REPORT OFFSHORE REPORTS

As November comes to a close the Hudson Canyon is still holding fish. The party boats are fishing the Southwest Corner with great catches of Longfin Tuna and a few Big Eyes & Swords mixed in. The water is still holding at 59 degrees at the end of November. The day time trolling bites for those who dare is insane. Yellowfins up to 150 lbs., Big Eyes in the 250 lbs. class and large Bluefin are still being trolled.

Chris "Wasbie" made a final canyon trip this past Saturday December 2nd. Chris came tight on two medium size Bluefins on the troll. One stayed & the other made good his escape. Chris's Bluefin came in @ a respectable dress weight of 150 lbs.! Nice way to end the season.

Fall Shark Fishing:

Few FTC boats like many others did not get in on the fall shark season. As of mid November with the water cooling down it will make shark fishing almost impossible as the Dog fish AKA Grey Cod have moved in.

Here is a humorous Sharking tagging story from Captain Bill Morrogh:

"We tagged the "Northern Blue Terror" (Blue Shark) this spring on 6/22/13 about 45 miles SE of Jones. The fish was retagged and our tag was returned the same day, 6NM SE of where we were, for a same day recapture.

Those monsters never stop eating!"

Inshore Action:

Captain John Jutt reports the following on the Blackfish front:

Captain John crewed with Paul Hilton F/V Emily S. The team hit the local reefs with a limit catch of Blackfish & two very fine keeper size Cod to round the day off.

Blackfish report from Captain Bill Minneo:

Captain Bill reports excellent catches of blackfish to ten lbs. Bill has been fishing the western spots such as the "911" wreck with limits every trip.

Blackish report from Bob Bohlert:

"Took a buddy from work out for some chilly blackfishing on the AB reef. Frigid day, nice pick - under the old 14" regs we would have had an easy limit, but we had 3 nice tog in the box at days end. Good FTC company in the vicinity of Tim Sherman's all new F/V "Betty III" and Captain Joe Masseria's F/V "Miss Lynn" all plying the same waters. So....around mid morning my buddy's rod doubles over and I am hoping this is his first slob tog.....here it comes....I see color.....wait...it's......a redfish??????"

Striped Bass Report:

Captain Mike Sullivan F/V Blue Jackets reports:

"The Bluejacket II made the 90 mile run down the beach from MTK to Jones on Sunday. Started off with 4-6' on the port quarter for the first 25 miles. Stopped off at Amagansett to jig under hundreds of birds. Didn't mark any bass. Scored with a few cocktail blues. What a disappointment! Next stop was Mecox, again under the birds, for nada. Stopped to jig bait balls east of Moriches again for nada. Finally made a few stops west of Moriches where the Capt. Lou and the Captree Princess were jigging (this is a long run for the Capt. Lou!). Managed 3 rats. Decided to head for Freeport after a bit of this making a few more drops along the way. The last 15 miles visibility closed down to

1/8 mile and less. Safely cleared Jones Inlet for the first time in two years with a little guidance from The Mikey Likes It. Thank you Grover and Mike.

This is the Bluejacket II's final trip for the 2013 season. Boat should be on the hard at the property in a week or two."

Out East Montauk Report:

Report from Captain Anthony Testa:

"With a descent forecast for November 16th we planned an offshore wreck trip. Lines off at 530 am and we headed to our first drop and picked some jumbo c bass and some real nice Pollack. We headed to the next piece and it was a total bail job on the c bass. We put our limit on ice in a short time and had a few short cod. Next stop was inshore in 100' of water and it was more c bass and one nice cod to round off the day. On way in we hoped to jig a few bass with reports of the herring arriving but the point was quiet with no birds, boats or signs of life. Back at the dock at 3 with a nice fall mixed bag."


